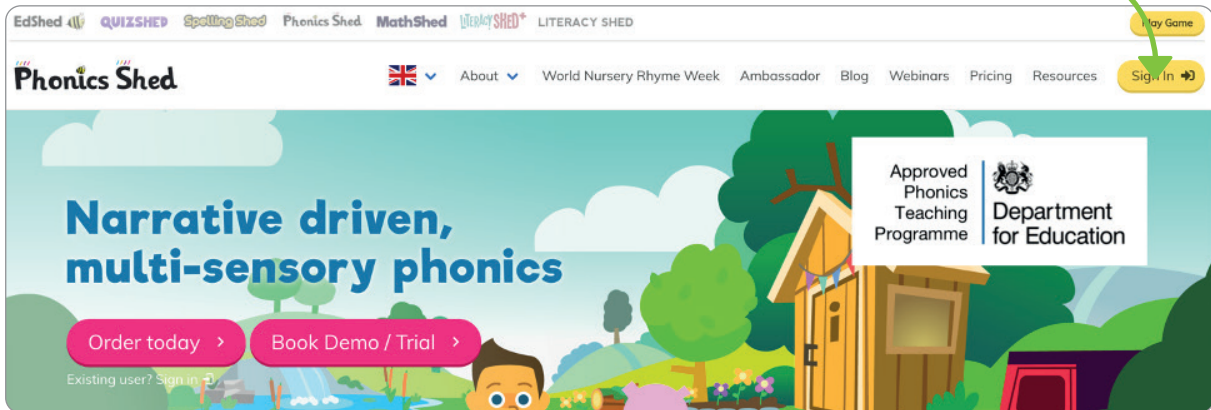


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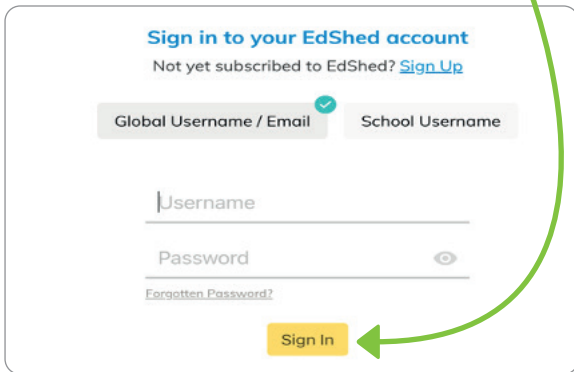
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Logging into Your Phonics Shed Trial

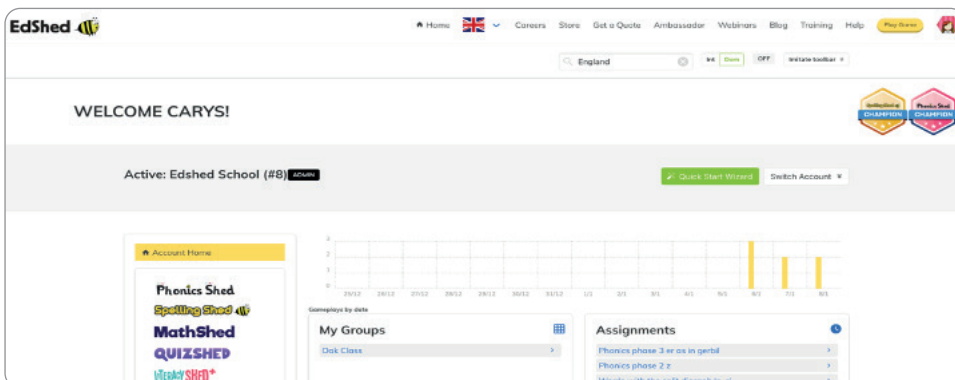
Visit www.edshed.com to login to Phonics Shed. Click on the 'Sign In' button.



Enter your login details and click on 'Sign In'.

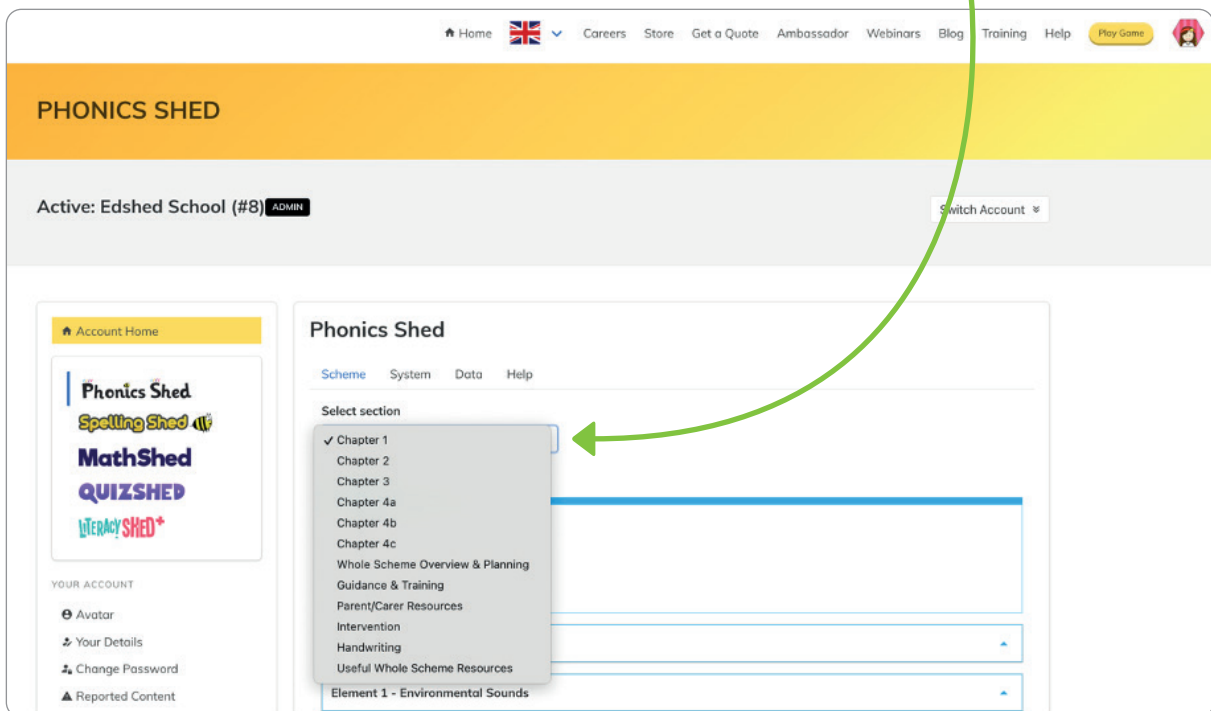


When you first login, you should automatically be taken to 'Account Home'.

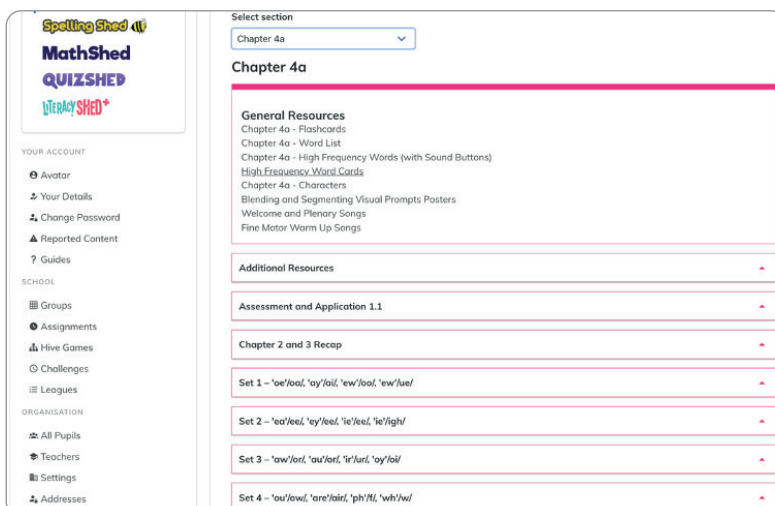


Locating the Phonics Shed Resources

Click the Phonics Shed product icon from the left-hand menu. This will take you to the 'Scheme' tab. Here you can look at whole scheme overviews and guidance. Select the different Chapters from the drop-down menu to begin exploring lessons and associated resources.



Once you have selected your Chapter, you will find the different sets of lessons. You have access to everything whilst using your trial.



Exploring Phonics Shed Lessons

Once you have clicked the drop-down in a 'set', then you will find everything you need to teach each lesson. Each set will have daily plans organised into full weeks (with supporting continuous provision plans) and additional consolidation and intervention planning. The teaching books, songs, flashcards, and formation animations are used to support the planning alongside specific printable resources. Decodable books linked to the set are also included, along with a book list of suggested external texts.

You can also use the lesson viewer to take you through each lesson and present the resources to the class, which correspond to the lesson plan.

Teaching Resources

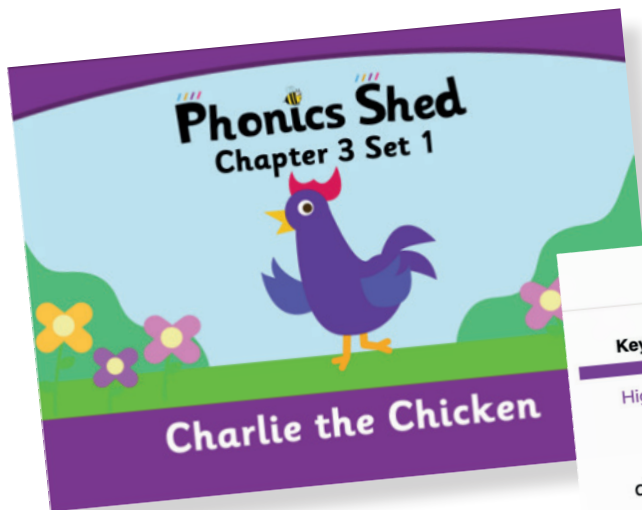

Additional Suggestions for Continuous Provision

- Additional small group activity.
- **Simplify** – cross out the pictures that do not contain the 'ch' sound. (Resource 12)
- **Expect** – read and match the 'ch' words and pictures. (Resource 13)
- **Extend** – Draw and label the things that Charlie likes to eat. (Resource 14)
- Chicken life cycle craft activity, chicken and egg count and match, chalk mark making. (Resource 15)
- Measure ingredients and make a chocolate cake.
- **Extension** - Spelling Shed/hdf resources, Stage 1, Lesson 3

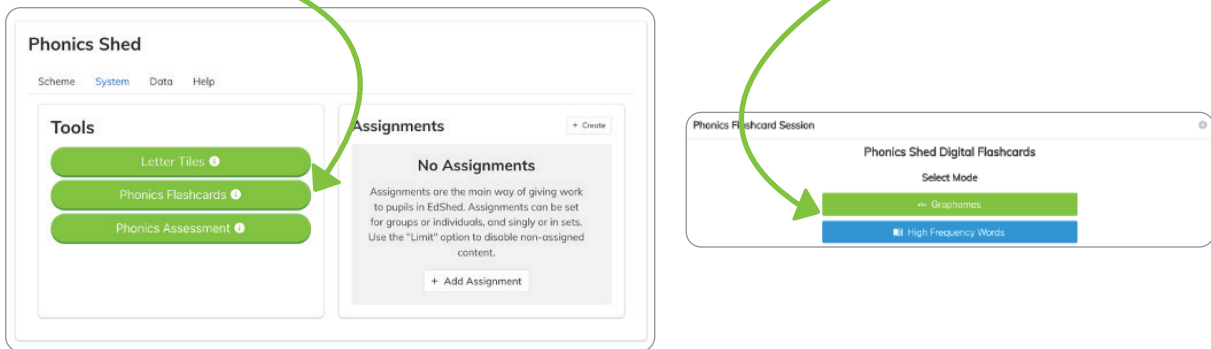


Printable Resources

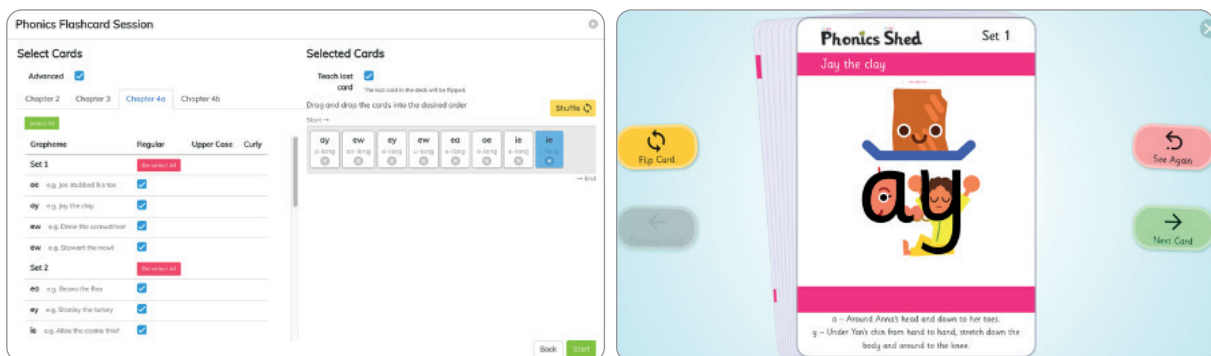
Printable resources have three different levels of scaffolding for independent activities: 'simplify', 'expect' and 'extend'.

Digital Flashcard Tool

On 'Phonics Shed', locate and click on the 'System' tab. Then you will see the green 'Phonics Flashcards' button. Once you click on this, you can choose 'Graphemes' or 'High Frequency Words'.



If you choose the 'Grapheme' option, there is the option to click 'Advanced' and select those GPCs you would like to revisit. Without clicking this option, you can select GPCs from a certain set. There is also the option to shuffle or reorder them. Then click 'start'.

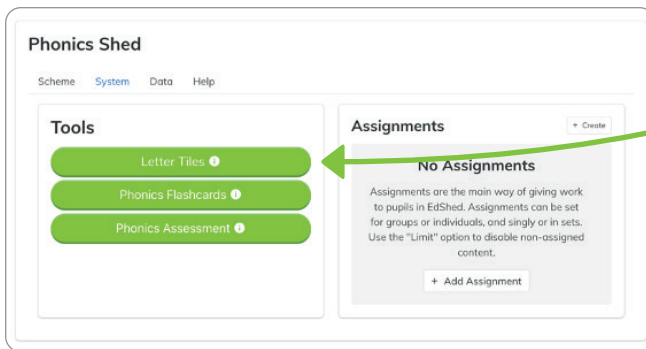


The flashcard tool has the option to flip the card to see the formation rhyme, as well as the option to see the card again if the pupils have struggled and need it repeated.

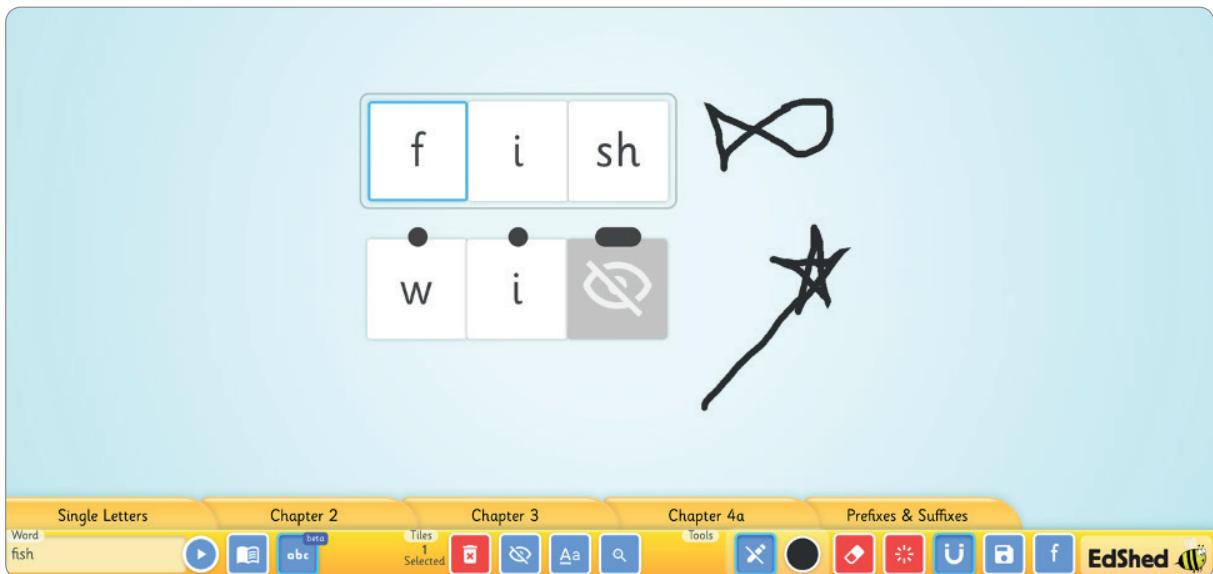
For the 'High Frequency Word' option, you can do the same as above and shuffle and rearrange the words.

Letter Tiles

On 'Phonics Shed', locate and click on the 'System' tab. Then you will see the green 'Letter Tiles' button.

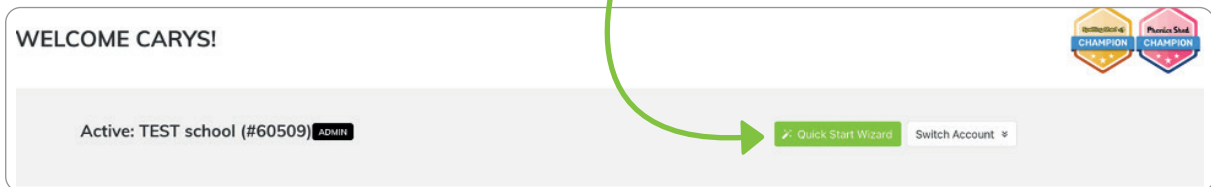


You can use this as an optional extra tool on your interactive whiteboard. It includes features such as hiding tiles, reading out a whole word, definitions, annotating and saving what you have done.

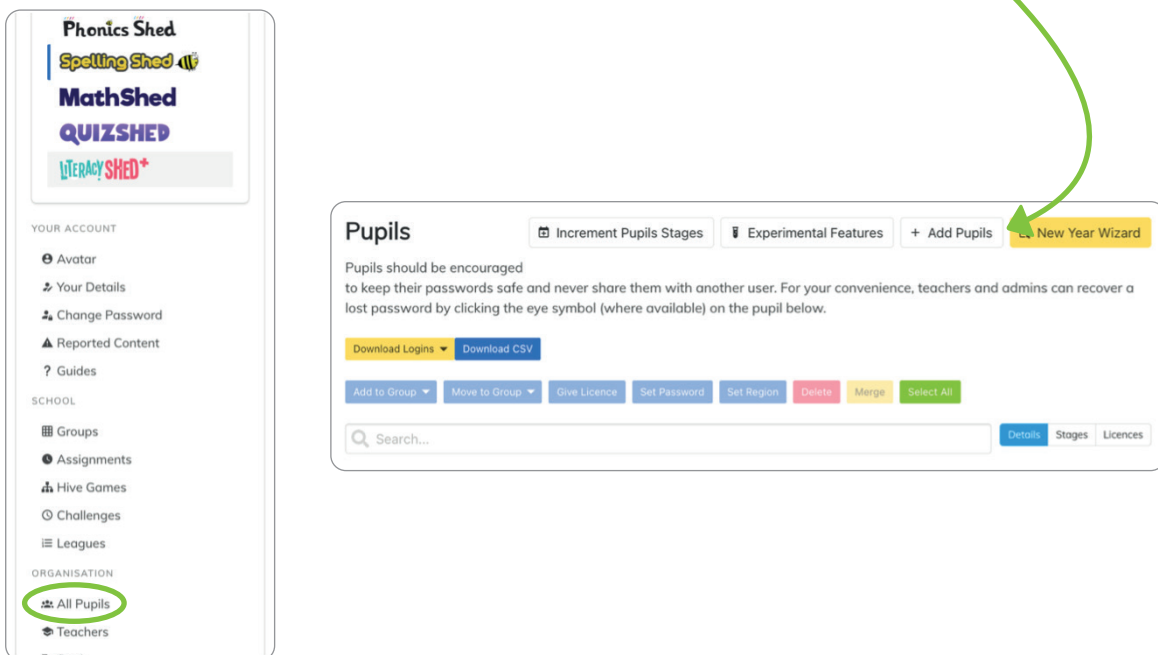


Creating Pupil Accounts

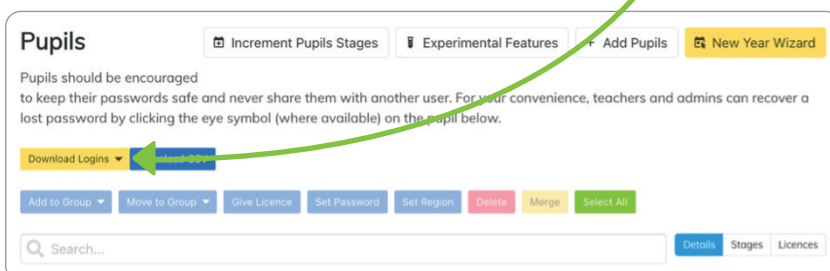
You can add demo pupils via the 'Quick Start Wizard' on the EdShed homepage and following the relevant options.



To add your pupils to your trial account. From your homepage, scroll down the left-hand menu and select 'All Pupils'. Click 'Add Pupils' to create pupil accounts, where you can add pupils manually or import them from a csv.

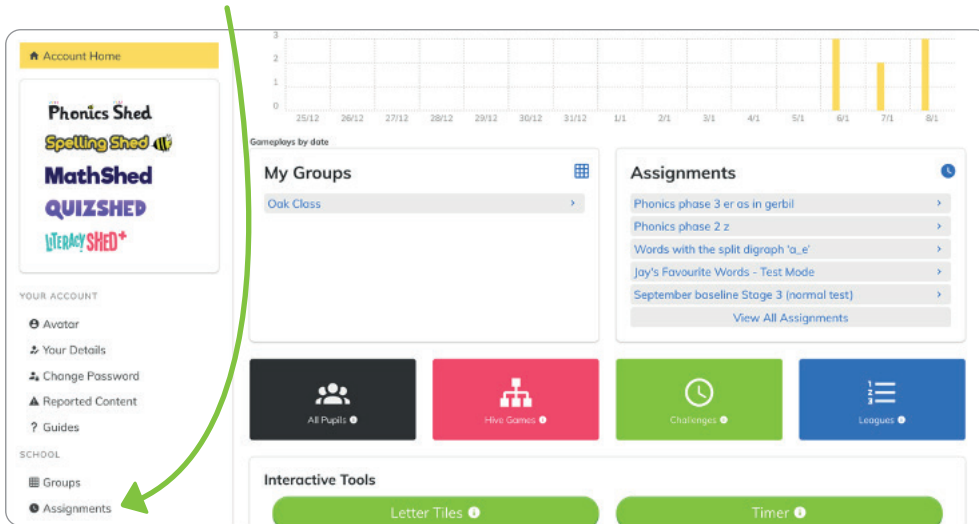


Once your pupils have been created, click the 'download logins' button and distribute login details to your pupils.



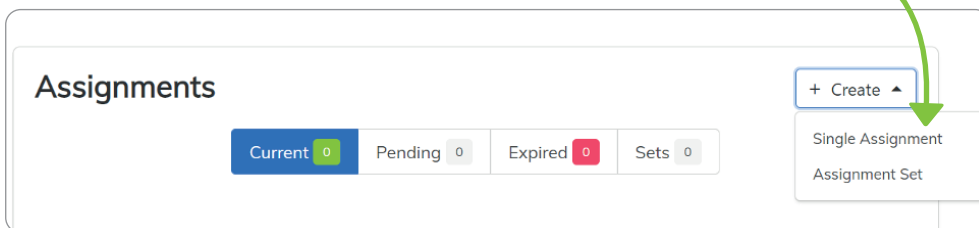
Setting Assignments

Click on 'Assignments' from on the menu on the left.

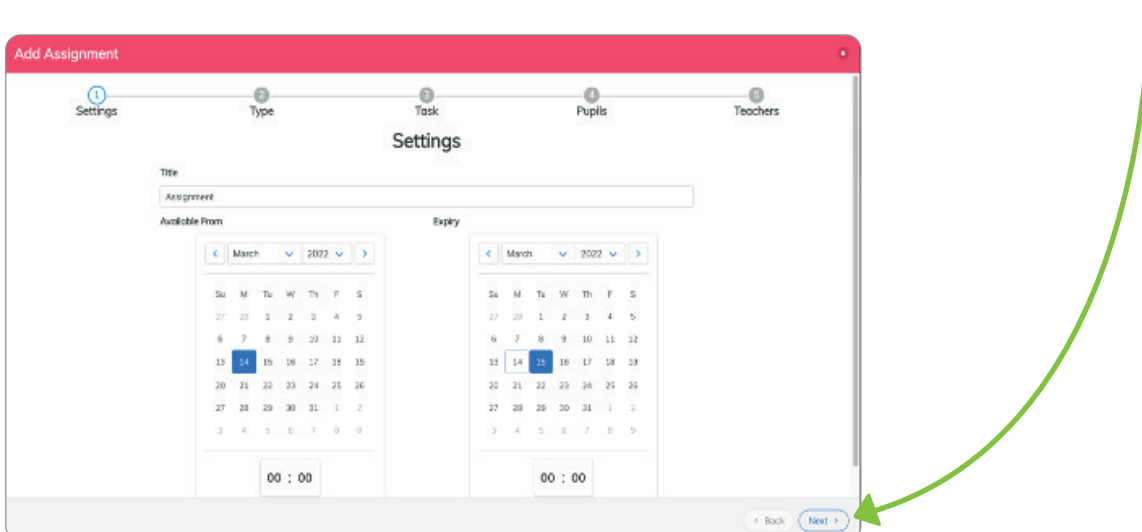


You will be able to access all your assignments on this page. To create a new assignment, click on 'Create'.

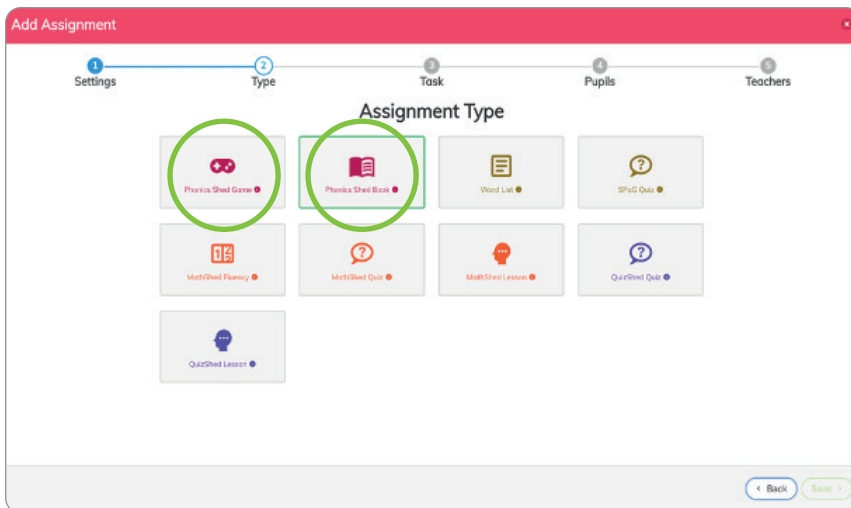
You can only create a Single Assignment for Phonics Shed.



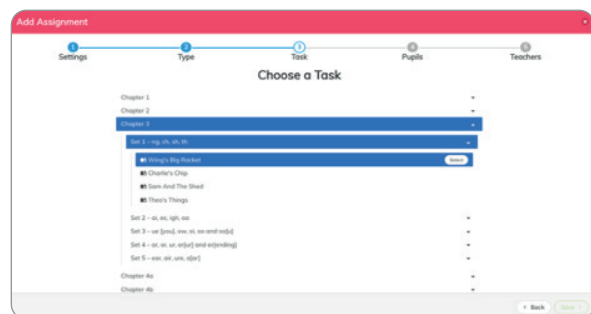
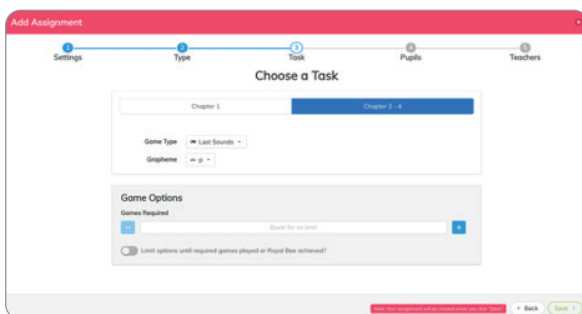
Fill in the title and select the dates you want the assignment to be available from and click 'next'.



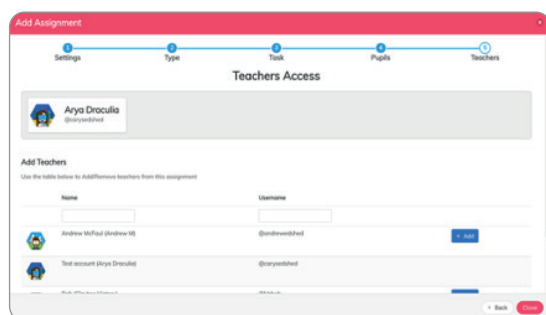
There are two assignment types in Phonics Shed - either 'Phonics Shed Game' or 'Phonics Shed Book' (decodable for pupils).



For both you will need to choose the Chapter and GPC relevant to your pupils, then select either the game type or eBook title.



Next, click on the children you wish to assign this eBook to. You can select your group from the drop down. Select 'Track Group' to quickly select all pupils in the chosen group.

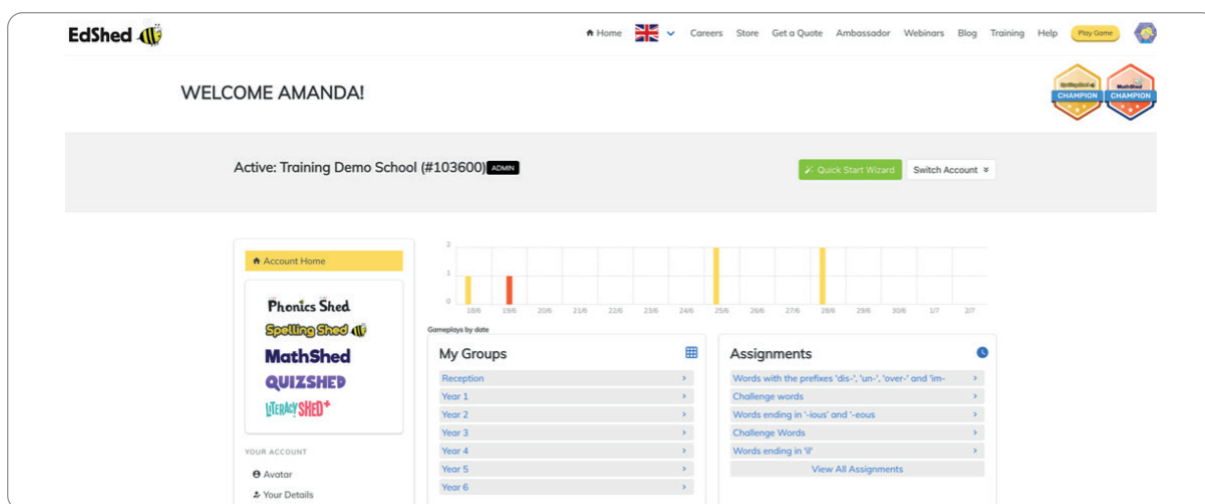


You can also add other teachers by clicking on the teacher tab. This means that other teachers can view the assignment but will not be able to edit it.

Pupils will be presented with a range of engaging practice games directly focussed on the GPC you have selected. Have a look through the Phonics Shed Garden and the different games on offer.

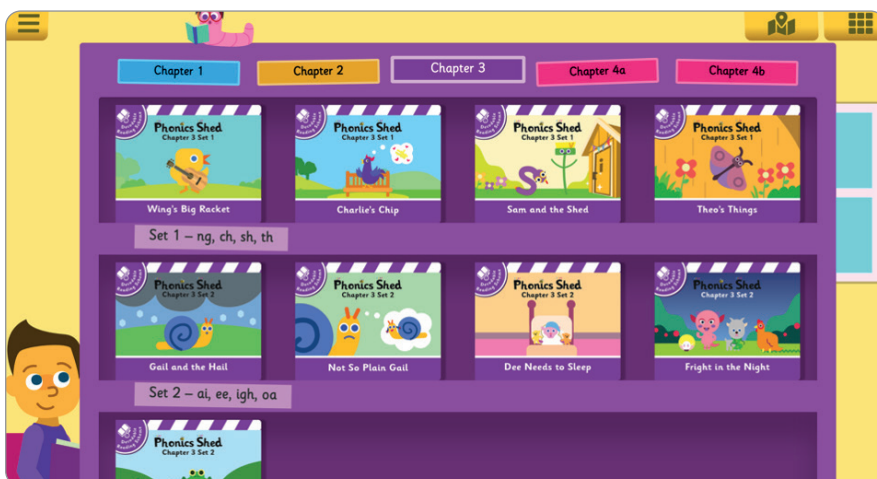

It is worth noting that there is a 'Limit Lists' option when setting an assignment so pupils only have access to the games and eBooks you have set them. However, for the purpose of the trial you can explore all of these to get a feel of Phonics Shed.



Viewing Assignment Results

This is a great way to monitor activities you have set. Go to the assignment section and click 'details' next to the assignment you would like to view. You will be able to see how many times each pupil has played, the level they have played on and the percentage correct.

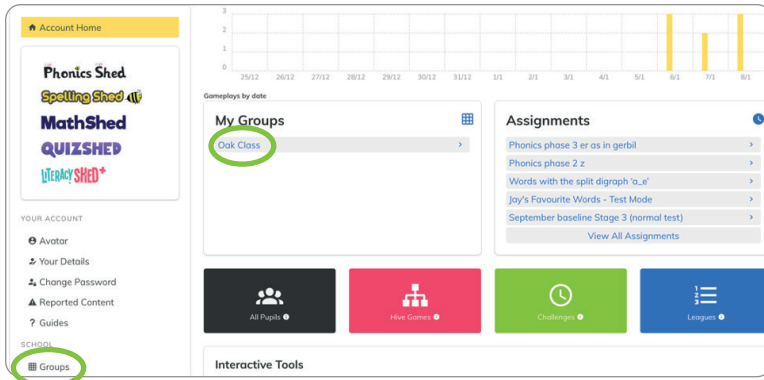

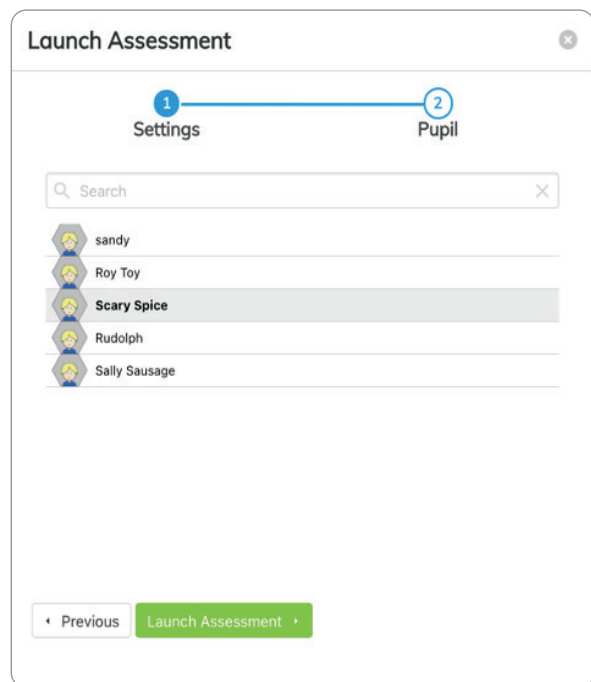
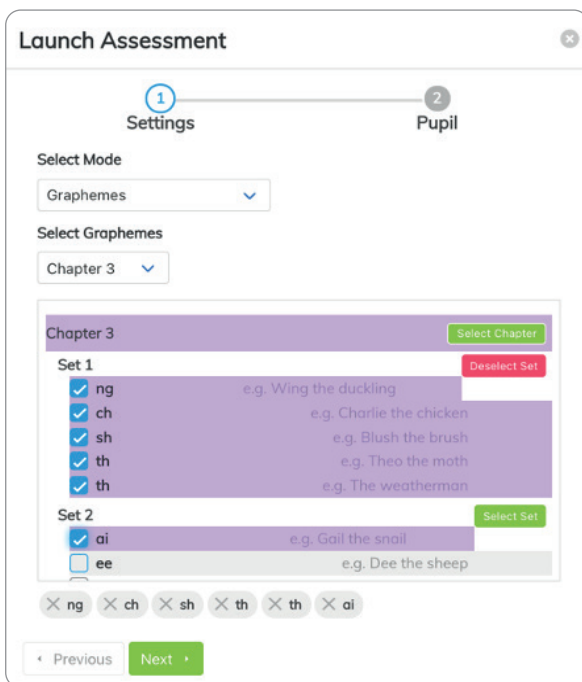
Assessment Sessions

Here you can assess either graphemes, words, or phonics screening check words. Go to your group page and you will find the below.

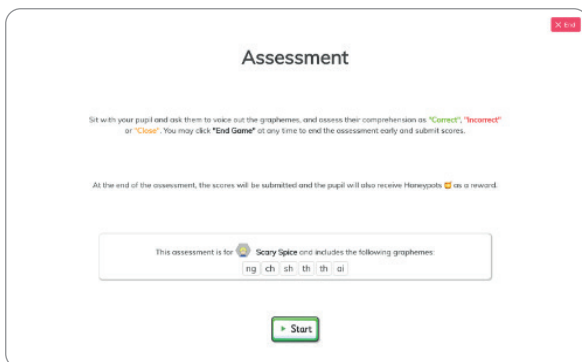
Click the 'Launch Assessment Session' button.



Then select, 'graphemes' from the drop down and the chapter of the graphemes you would like to assess. Then you can 'select chapter' or specific sets from that chapter like below. Then click 'next' and select the pupil you are assessing, then click 'Launch Assessment'. You can also assess word lists here.



An instructional page will come up, then you can click 'Start'. You can click 'End' at any time in the assessment to save the scores.



Children to sound the GPC and you to mark their matching phoneme using the buttons given.

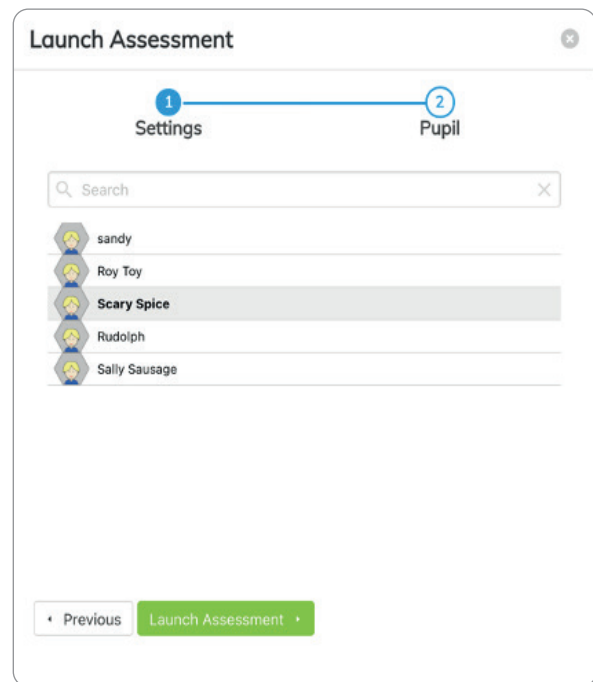
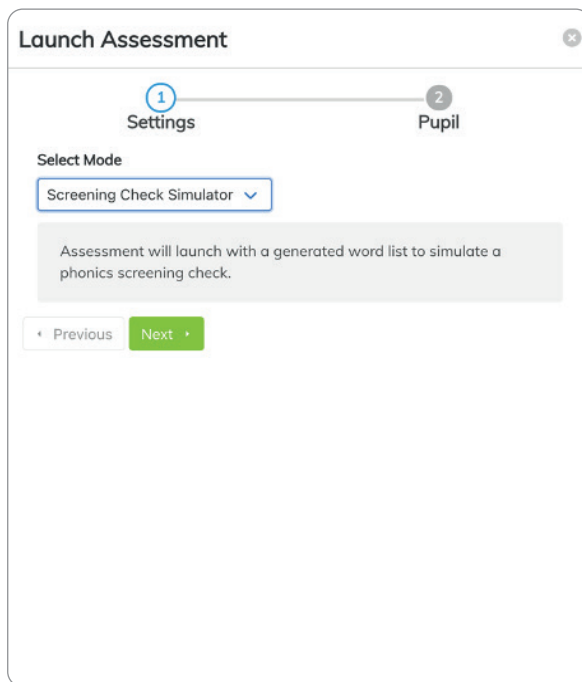
Phonics Check Simulator

A great way to get your pupils ready for the Phonics Screening Check!

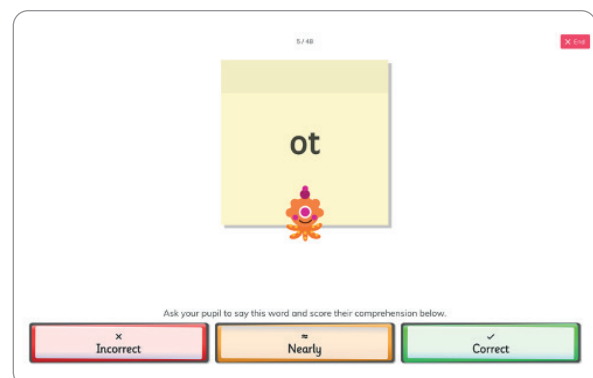
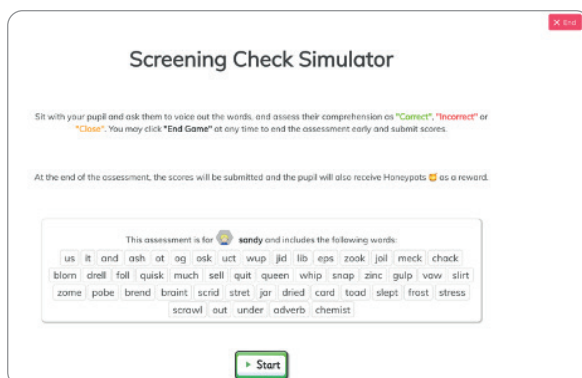
Click the 'Launch Assessment Session' button.

Select 'Phonics Check Simulator' from the modes, then select the word list you would like to assess. Either from our scheme, your lists, or favourites. Then, click 'Next' and select your pupil. Finally, click 'Launch Assessment'.



An instruction screen will come up as before, then you can click 'Start'.



NOTE

If it is an alien word, an alien icon will appear.

Individual Phonics Data

After you have selected your class in groups, stay on the 'Pupils' tab. This will show all the children in your class. You can also access your children on 'All Pupils'. Click on the pupil you wish to look at.

Once you have clicked on a child, you will be taken to the 'Pupil Setup' tab. You can access the child's password, change password, reward or fine and see the child's score.

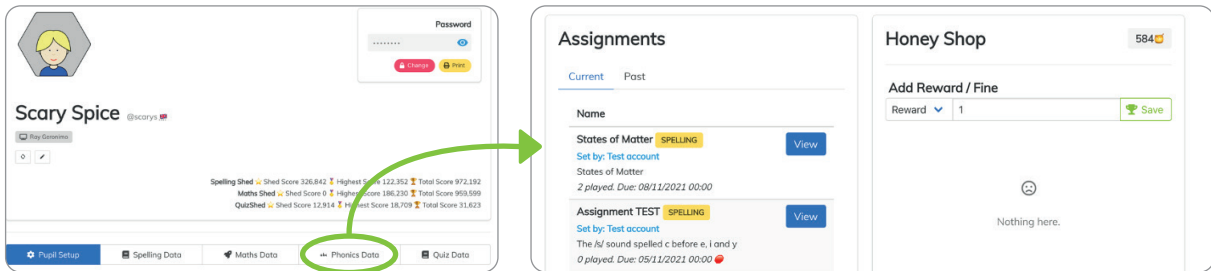
