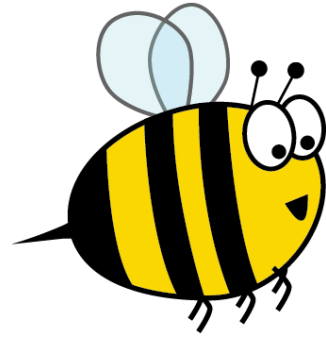

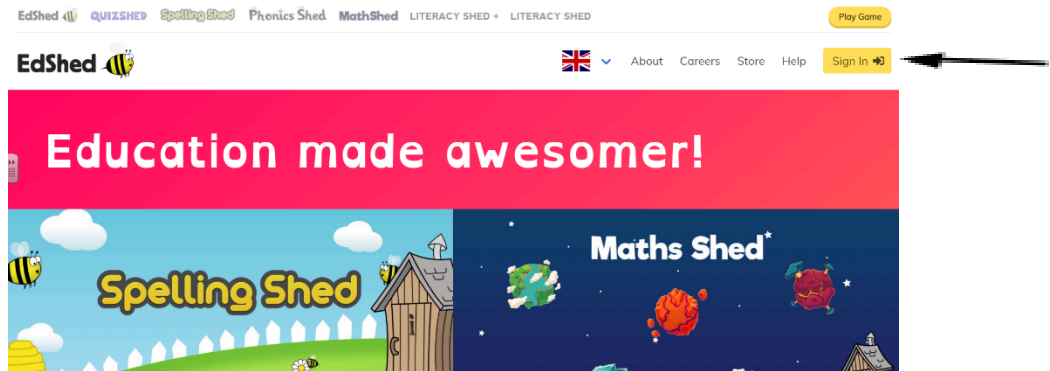

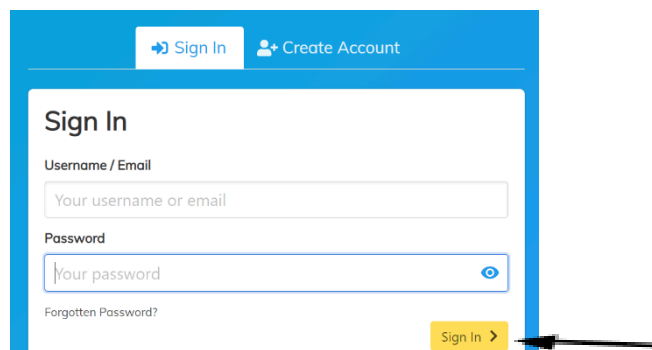
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Logging into EdShed

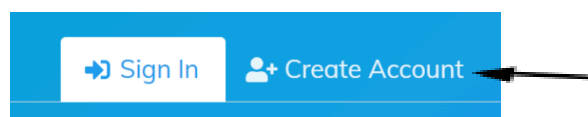
Visit <https://www.edshed.com/> to login to Spelling Shed. Click on the 'Sign In' button.



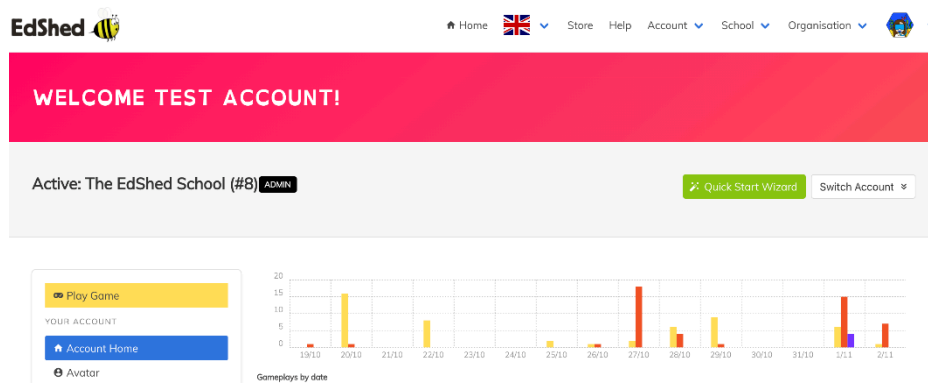
Enter your login details and click on 'Sign In'



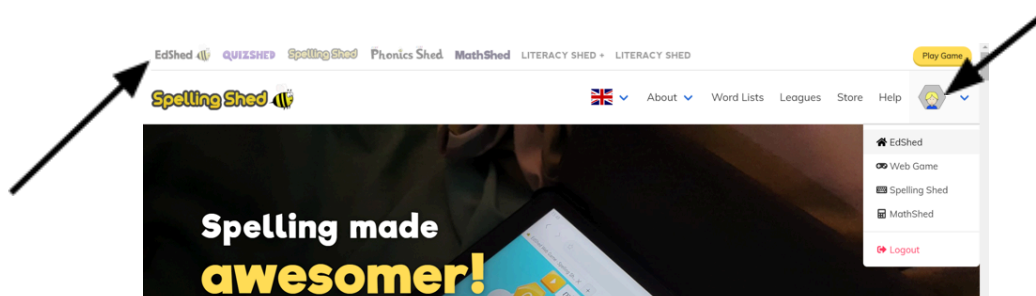
If you haven't created an account, click on 'Create Account'. Follow the instructions on screen. You will need the joining code from a spelling shed admin.



When you first login, you should automatically be taken to 'Account Home'.

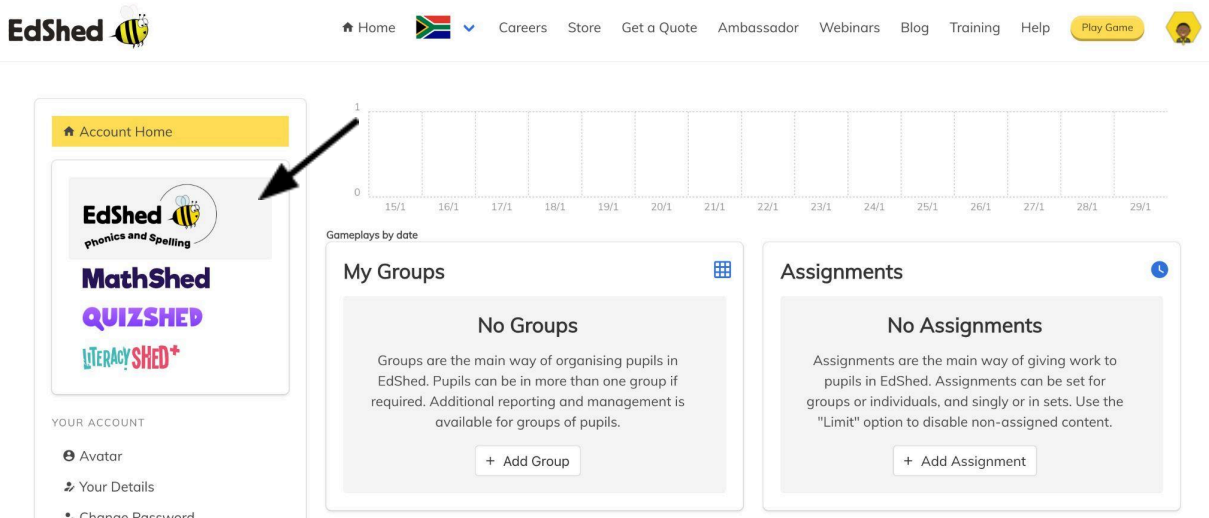


If you are not taken to 'Account Home' straightaway, click on your avatar on the right hand side and then select 'EdShed' or click on EdShed which can be located top left hand corner.

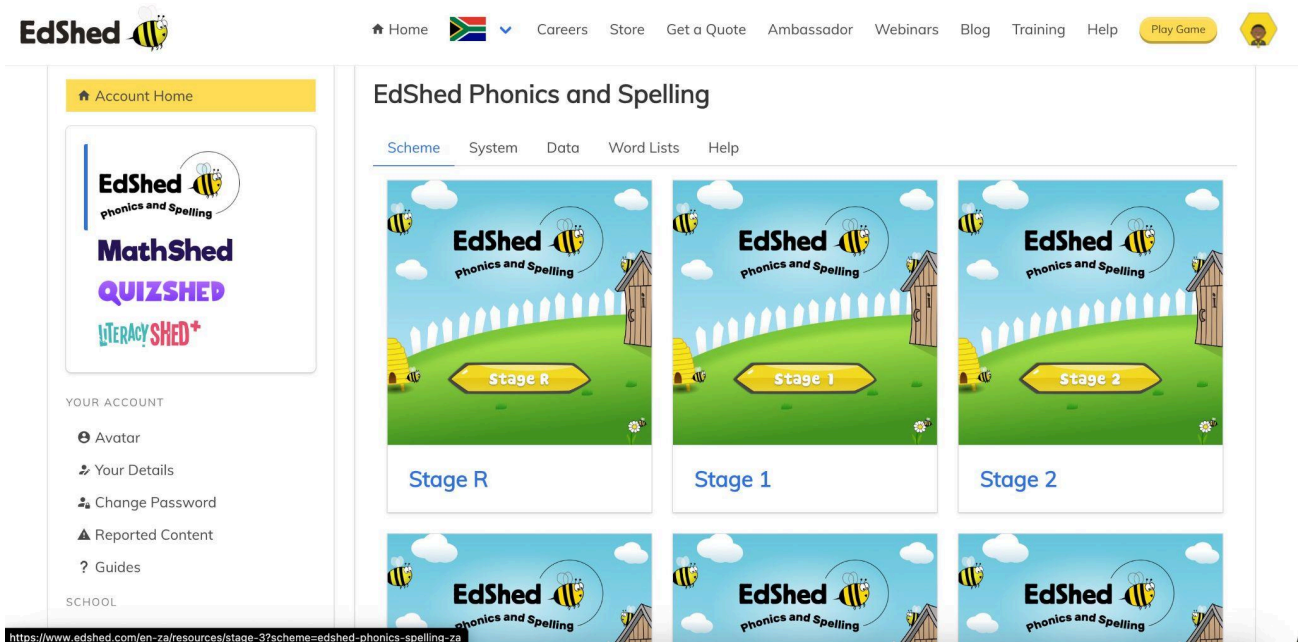


Locating the EdShed Resources

On 'Account Home', locate and click on the 'EdShed' Logo.




You will be taken to a page where you can select your year group. Stage 1 is Grade 1, Stage 2 is Grade 2 etc.

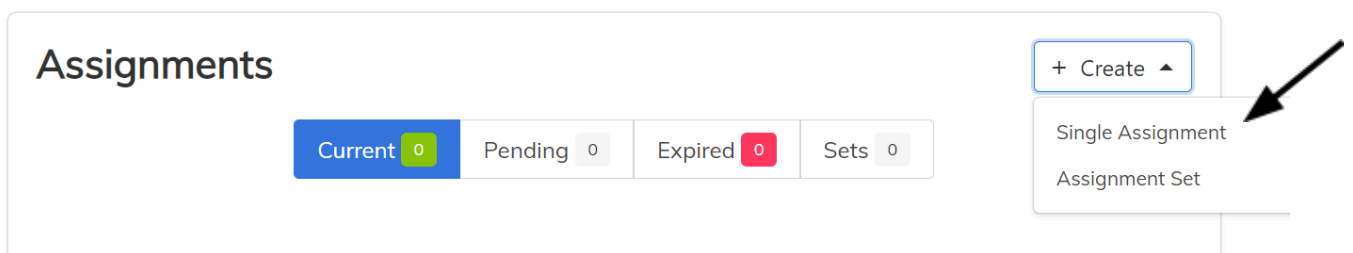
Assigning a Spelling List to a Child

Look on the left-hand side at the menu. Click on 'Assignments'.



You will be able to access all of your assignments on this page. To create a new assignment, click on 'Create'.

You can create a single assignment, or an assignment set.

Give the assignment a title and select the dates you want the spellings to be available for. To select a list from the scheme, choose your year group where it says, 'Choose a stage' and 'Choose a list'. Alternatively, choose your own list or one

from your 'favourite lists'.

'Limit options' means that pupils will be limited to only play the spelling list you have set, you can add a number of games required for them to practise before they have access to other games or keep blank for no limit.

Once you have filled in the details, click on 'Save'.

Assignment Set

If you want to set more than one assignment for your class, you can select 'Assignment Set'. You will be asked to select a group (your class), a stage (year group) and the date you want the assignments to start.

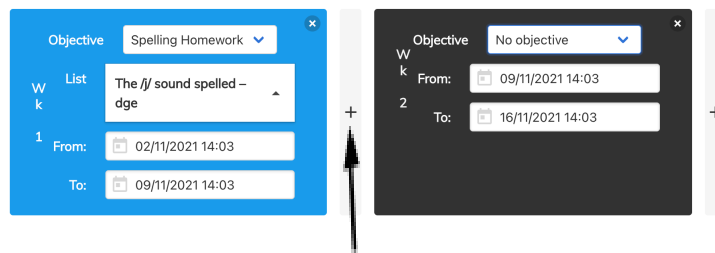
You can swap the weeks around by dragging them and you can delete a week by clicking on the 'x' symbol on the top right of each week, check that you are happy with the assignments and dates, then click 'Save'.

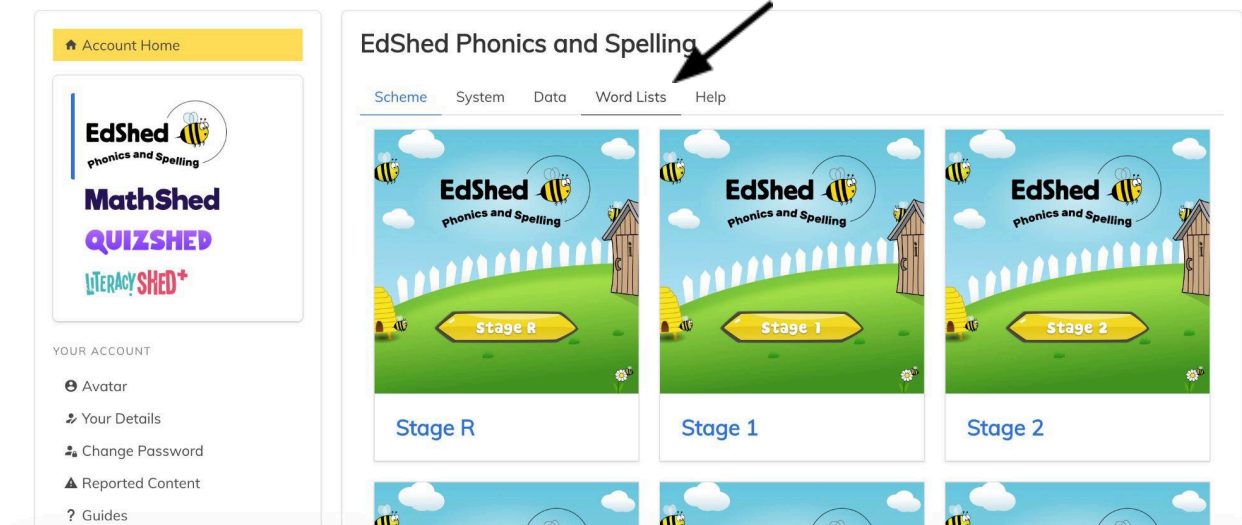

Creating your own list

Click on 'EdShed' Logo then click on 'Word Lists'. This will take you to the spelling scheme lists and the lists you have already created.



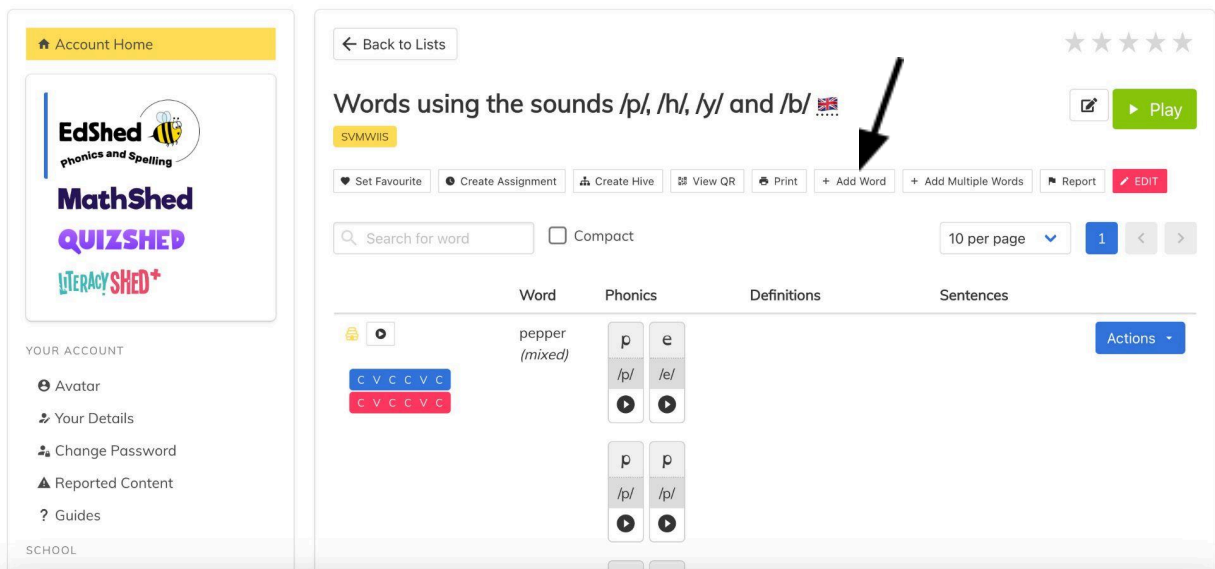
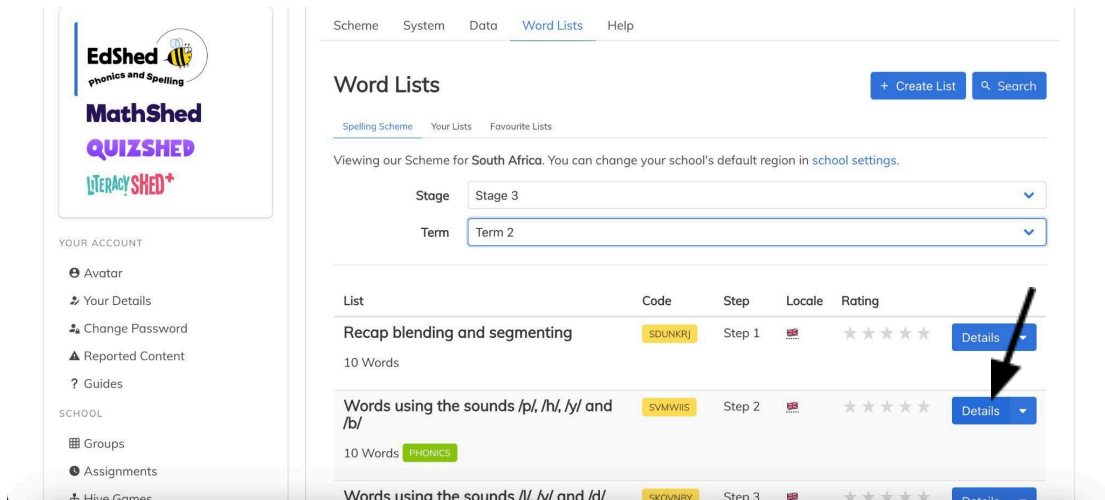
Click on 'Create List'.

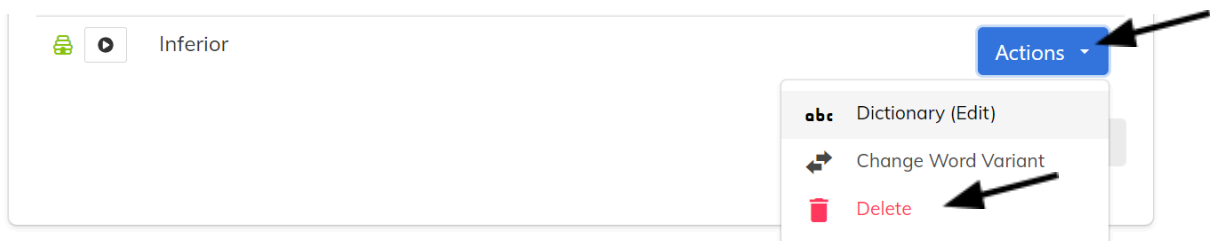
Give the list a name and type in the spellings you wish to include. The 'Phonics' toggle gives you the option to have the letters sounded out on the keyboard, rather than letter names, when the list is played by the pupils. Click on 'Save' when you have finished.

This will take you to the list. EdShed will add a definition for the majority of words, if not please see 'How to edit the definitions of words'.

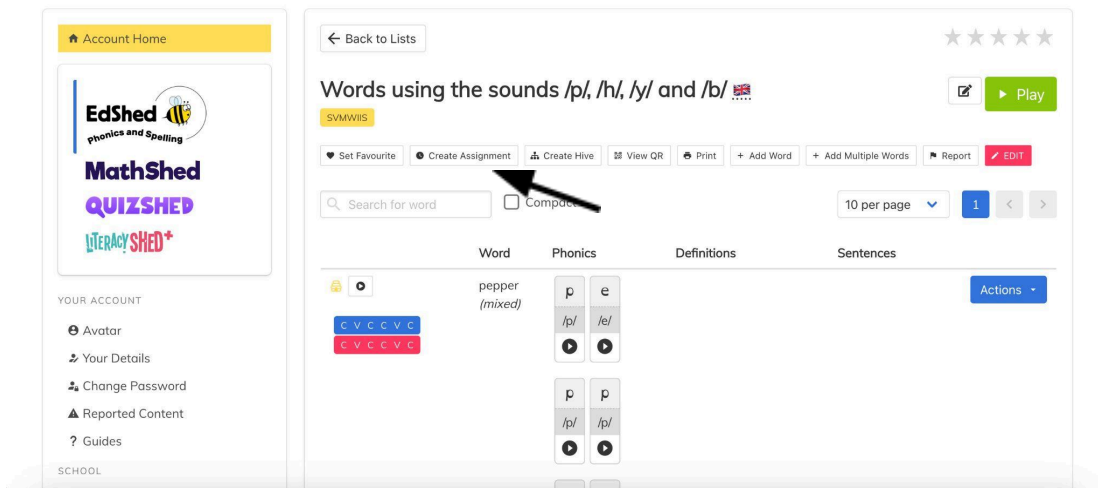
If you wish to add another word to your list, select the “Stage” & “Term” you want to add a word too, then click details of the list you want to add words to and then click ‘+ Add Word’.



To delete a word from the list, click on ‘Actions’ and then ‘Delete’.

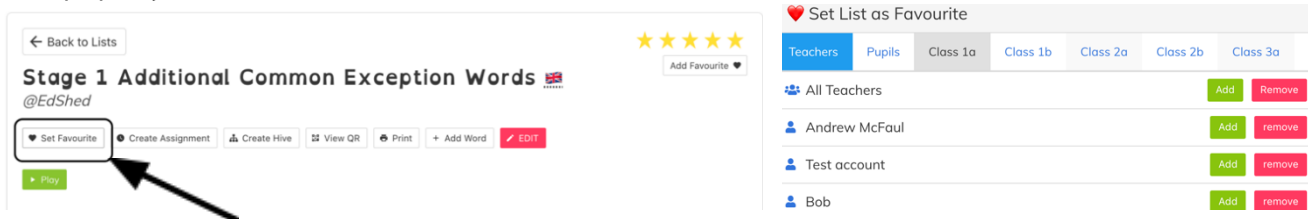


To assign your list to a child, click on 'Create Assignment'. You will need to follow the same steps as mentioned above.



How to 'favourite' a list

Favouriting a list allows you to share it with other teachers or pupils. Pupils can then play the list you have set. When you have a word list open click, 'Set Favourite'. Then select the teachers or pupils you wish to share it with.



How to edit the definition of a word

EdShed will add a definition for the majority of words in a list, like below.

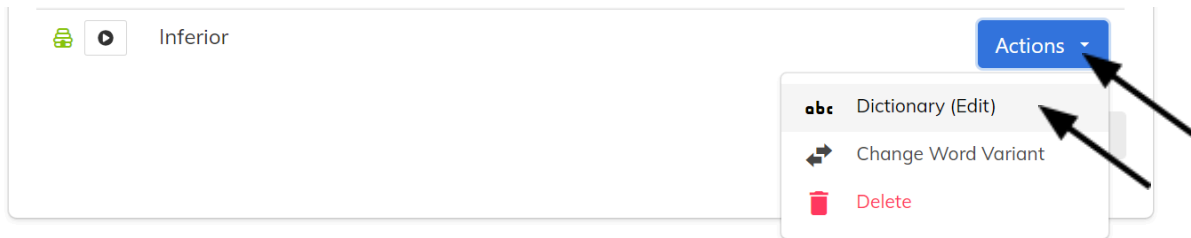

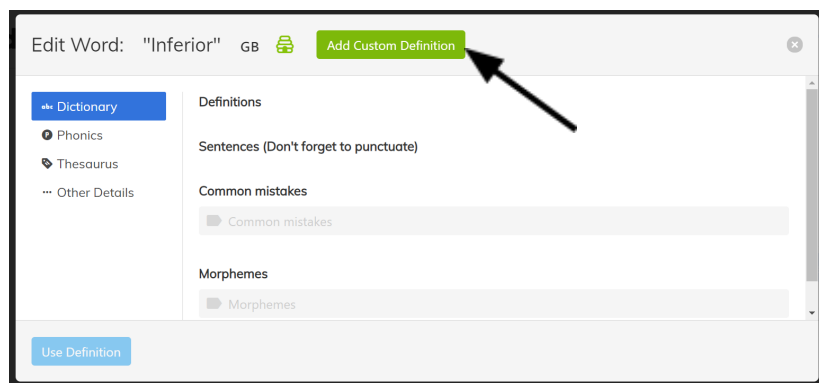

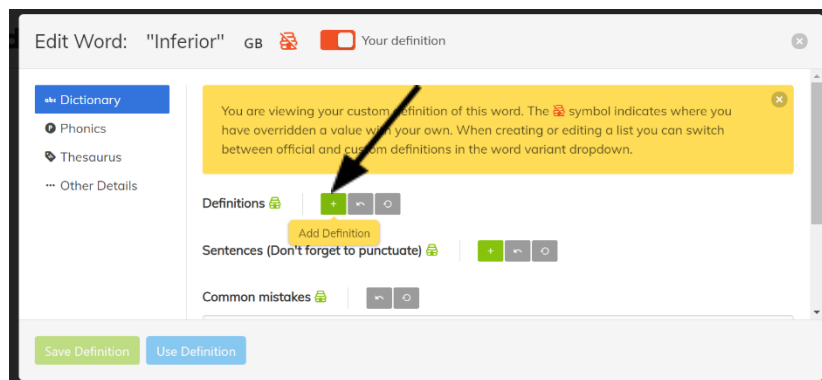
If the word does not have a definition, you can add one yourself clicking on 'Actions'. Then select 'Dictionary (Edit)'.



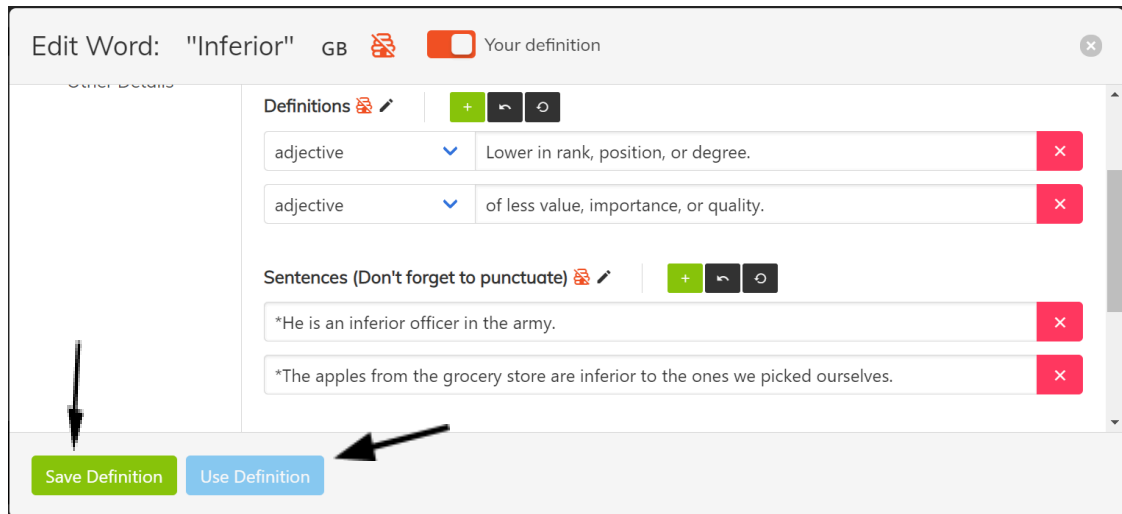
Click on 'Add Custom Definition'.



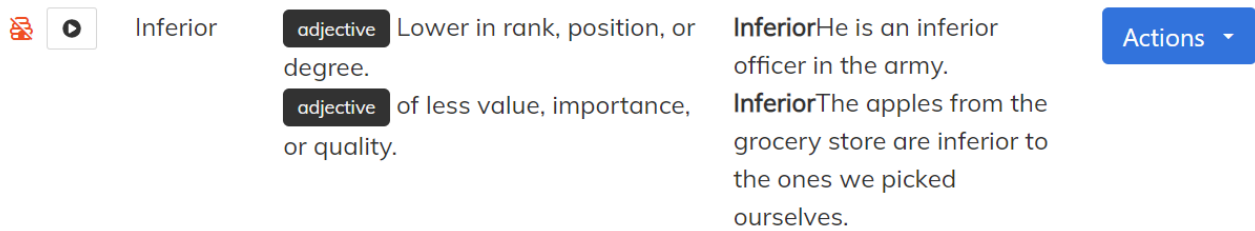
Select the '+' next to Definitions'. You can also add sentences using the word by clicking '+'.

Click on 'Save Definition'. This will most likely shut this window down. Click on 'Actions' again and then select 'Use Definition'.




Editing phonics information

To edit the way the word is broken down, select 'phonics' in the menu on the left.

Editing words to include a capital letter

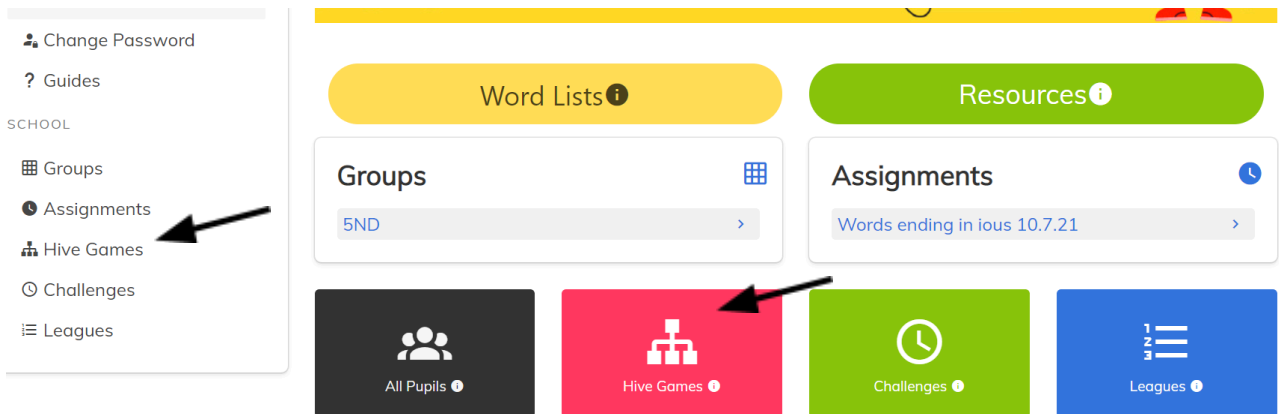
If you need a name to have a capital letter, click the pencil icon next to the word, edit it in the box and click the floppy disk icon to save.



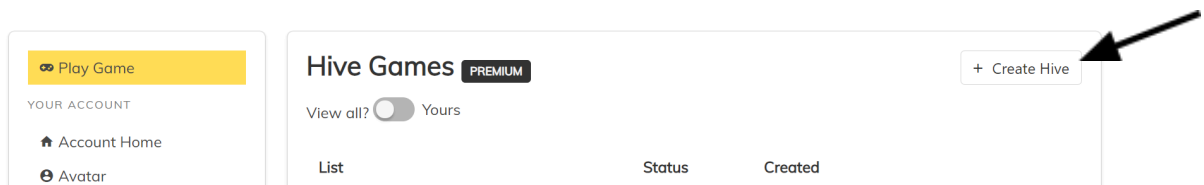
Hive Games

Hive games are interactive spelling checks where children are given the same spellings at the same time as each other, as they would in a spelling test. Hive games are played live so if someone joins the game late, they will miss the words at the start of the game. To join a hive game, you need a code.

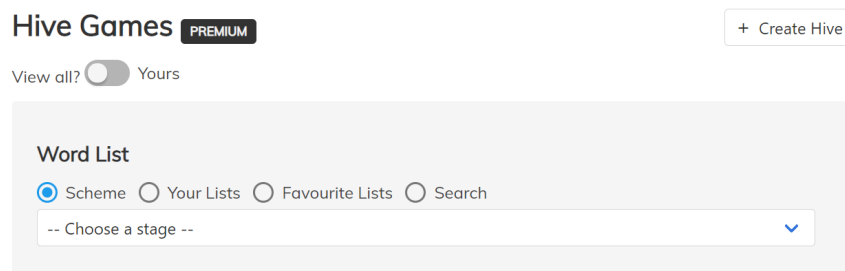
Select 'Hive Games' from the menu on the left hand side or select the 'Hive Games' option on the 'Account Home' page.



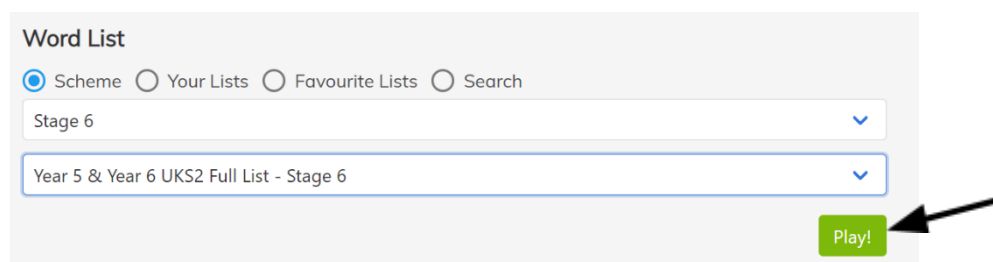
Click on '+ Create Hive'.

When the game has finished, select 'More' to access pupil's data. Here you can view a pupil's score out of 10 and total points score. You will also be able to see which words were spelled correctly and which words need to be revisited.

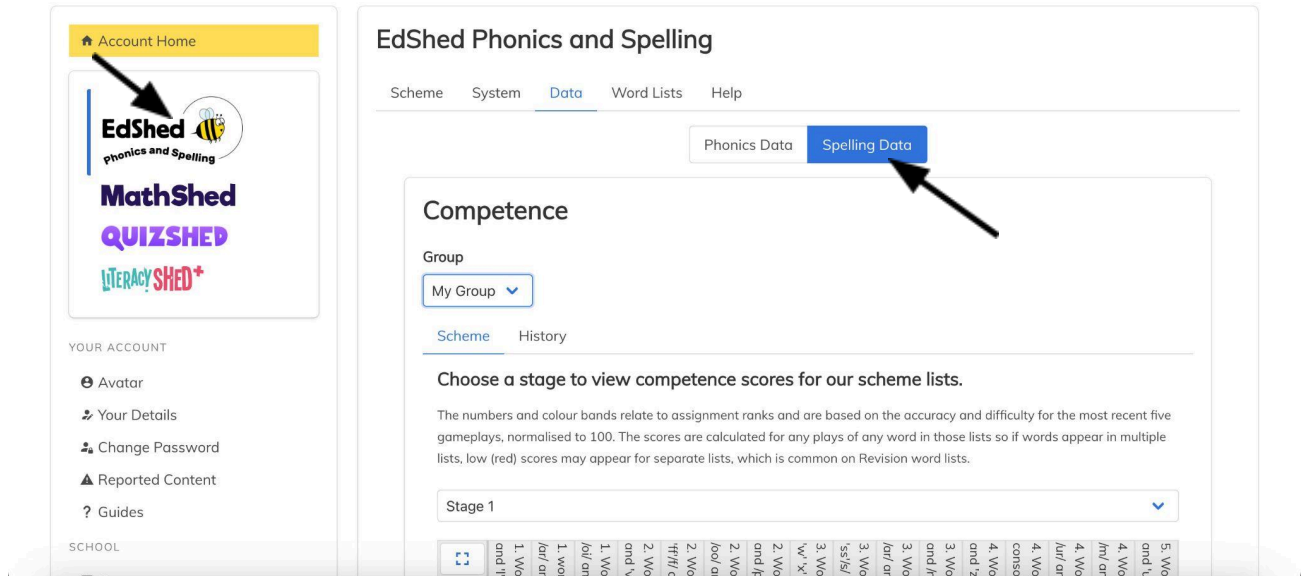

Choose a stage to view competence scores for our scheme lists.

The numbers and colour bands relate to assignment ranks and are based on the accuracy and difficulty for the most recent five gameplays, normalised to 100. The scores are calculated for any plays of any word in those lists so if words appear in multiple lists, low (red) scores may appear for separate lists, which is common on Revision word lists.

Choose a stage

You will be shown a competency grid which shows all of the objectives covered over the year. You may notice that objectives that haven't been taught have a low score. This could be because a word appears in more than one spelling list. It is RAG-rated to show the children's competency.

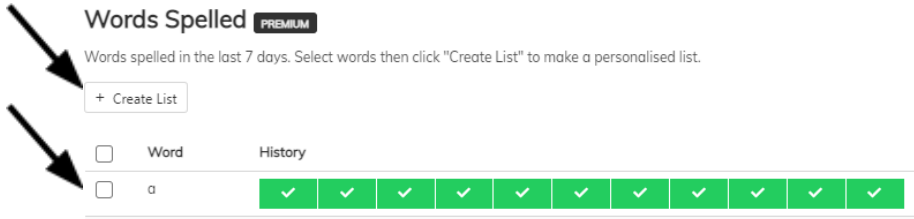

You can see that most children have struggled to spell the word 'applicable' correctly, whereas all children could spell 'according'.

You can select words which have been spelled incorrectly by selecting the box on the left hand side. You can then click on 'Create List' to create a list including all of the words the children have found tricky.



Individual Spelling Data

Click on "Groups", then click "Details" or the name of the group. This will show all of the children in your class. You can also access your children on 'All Students'. Click on the pupil you wish to look at.

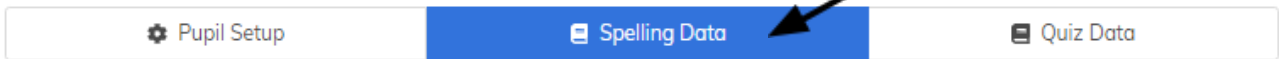

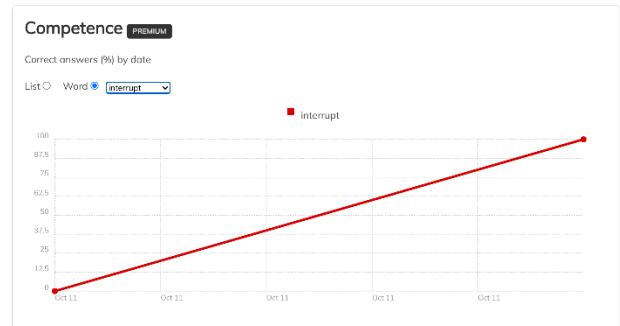
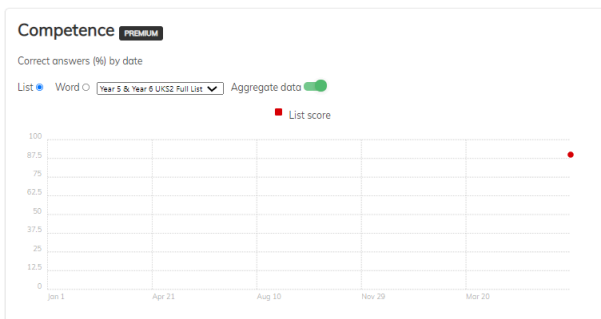

You will also be able to access the history of what has been played by the child.

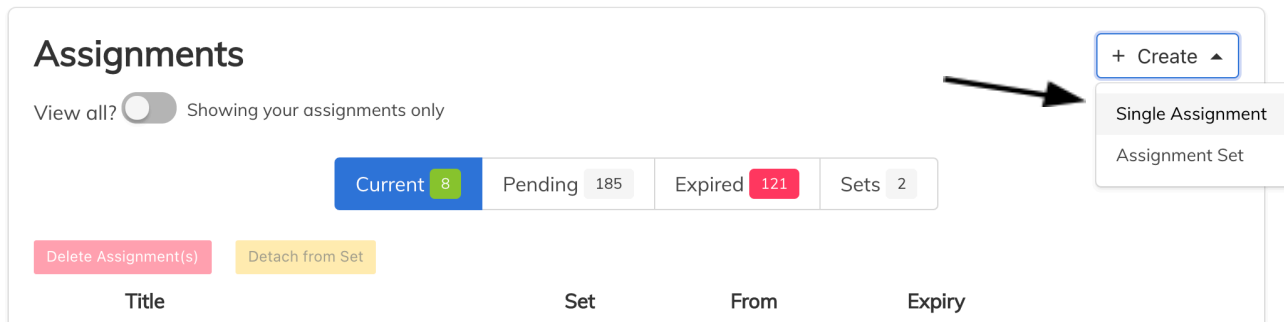

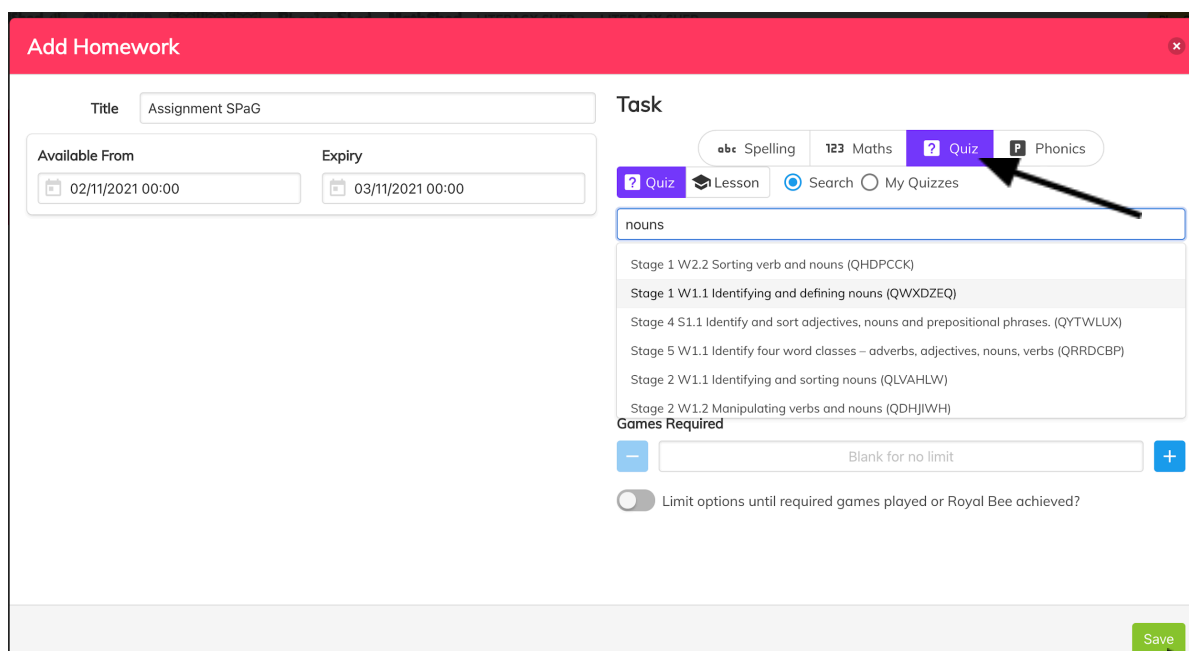

Setting a SPaG (Quiz) assignment

Go to the assignment section and click 'create' then 'single assignment'.



Then add a title and dates to set the assignment. Select 'quiz' and search the name of the SPaG PowerPoint. Select the correct accompanying quiz from the drop-down menu. There is a quiz to accompany most SPaG PowerPoints, but there is not one for each.

How to create a Custom League

Custom leagues are used to see data from a chosen group of pupils. This can include pupils from multiple groups or classes and even teachers.

Custom leagues can be based on their scores, amount of games played or total number of correct answers they have given.

Scoring

We have several different ways of scoring on our Spelling Shed online game:



Shed Score

This is the main score used for leagues and is the total score from the past seven days. This may go down as well as up. It is rolling total which is calculated live, and the score is stored after each game play. For example, if you earned 30 million points on Wednesday, the following Tuesday those points would be included in the Shed Score but on Wednesday, those points are now more than seven days old, so they stop being included in the score.



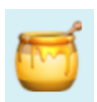
Your highest score
